



Club DC Code of Conduct Club 2017 & 2018

Code of Conduct for Club Members-

Club student members must adhere to the code of conduct to qualify and participate in Club events and the trip.

Each member will demonstrate the following behaviors at all meetings, class activities, fundraising events, and while on the trip. Failure to meet the code of conduct will result in removal from the Club and all associated activities.

The student member will:

1. be responsible for meeting posted deadlines, turning in forms at specified times and dates as required for fundraisers and required club information
2. attend the REQUIRED Family Meeting in February or March
3. attend the two (2) REQUIRED after school Member Meetings
absence from a required meeting may be grounds for removal from the trip and the Club
4. maintain a pattern of satisfactory citizenship as outlined in the following Rules of Eligibility
5. not earn a referral for academic dishonesty, detention, or be suspended
6. demonstrate respect for his/her fellow members, students, club leaders, volunteers, and community

Rules of Eligibility for Club Members-

The member's last 7th grade report card must not have more than one (1) N or U citizenship grade. If so, the member will be on probation until the first quarter report card. ¹

The member may not earn more than one (1) N or U citizenship grade per quarter report card during their eighth (8th) grade year. If more than one (1) N or U has been received a meeting with Club leaders is required.²

Members with ***three (3) or more N's or U's*** will be ineligible for the Club and trip.³

If a member has ***five (5) or more unexcused tardies*** to school in one quarter, a meeting with Club leaders will be required.⁴

The number and seriousness of office referrals is considered part of a negative pattern of behavior and may result in a violation of the code of conduct and removal from the trip.



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¹ First quarter report cards issued in October will determine the member status on probation. Continued negative behavior with more than one (1) N or U may result in removal from the Club. The member's probation status may be extended with limitations. Final qualification for the trip will be determined no later than 5 days prior to November 30.

Probation status: members will be notified no later than September 10 if they are on probation due to their 7th grade final report card. Members joining after Sept 10 will have immediate review of grades.

² Members receiving one (1) or two (2) N or U citizenship grades will be required to meet with Club leaders and parents to resolve the status of membership. This meeting must take place within 10 days of the receipt of member's report card.

³ Three (3) or more N's or U's in citizenship on any quarter report card will result in removal from the Club and trip. Deposit payments, if made, will be refunded if removal is before Nov 30. Additionally, progress reports with three (3) or more N's or U's in citizenship following October and proceeding the trip will result in removal.

⁴ Five (5) tardies in one (1) quarter may result in removal from the Club. Deposit payments, if made, will be refunded if removal is before Nov 30.

The following situations: academic dishonesty, detention, suspension, or Office referrals will be individually reviewed per member prior to any action of dismissal.
